WINDSHIELD PLACARD: The large windshield placard that comes in your credentials packet acknowledges your registration, indicates to security and parking personnel that you have paid, and must be displayed at all times. If you decide to leave the grounds in your motorhome for any reason, you must display this window placard to re-enter.

TOW CAR HANGER: This hanger in your credentials packet should be displayed from the rear view mirror of your towed or towing vehicle. When returning to the grounds in your vehicle, you must display the tow car hanger in order to re-enter.

EMERGENCY LOCATOR CARD: After you have been parked, please fill out your locator card (in your credentials packet) and turn it in at the Welcome/Information Desk in the Fullenwider Building (Building 9). This locator card is the only means we have of finding you in the event of an emergency or if friends want to know where you are parked. Please be specific about your location (check signs posted near your location). Also, please check to be sure that your RV's or towing vehicle's license plate number is printed clearly.

NAME BADGES: Name badges (in your credentials packet) must be worn to gain admittance to the exhibit areas and all other activities. There is a space on the back of the badge to indicate emergency information and your parking location.

WESTERN AREA SOUVENIRS: Hatpins are your mementos of the Indio rally. You will receive them when you pick up your Welcome Bag at the Welcome Desk. If there is a sufficient supply, the hatpins will be available at the Information Desk in the Fullenwider Building 9 for a cost of \$2.00 each.

COFFEE & PASTRIES IN THE MORNING: Early morning coffee, doughnuts, rolls, or muffins will be offered for your enjoyment in The Fullenwider Building 9 from 7:00 a.m.-9:00 a.m.

FIRST-TIME ATTENDEE RIBBONS: If you indicated on your registration form that you are attending your first Western Area Rally, we will enclose red First-Time Attendee ribbons in your credentials packet. These attach to your badges so experienced members can recognize you and be available to answer your questions.

FIRST-TIME ATTENDEE ORIENTATION: Plan to arrive early so you can attend the meeting for all first-time attendees on Wednesday, January 7, 2026, in The Fullenwider Building 9 from 12:30 p.m.-1:30 p.m. Following the meeting will be the Chapter Fair where you can visit with representatives from The Western RV Association (WRVA) chapters.

NOTE: Arrive early Wednesday morning so you can get parked in time to attend this orientation or arrive a day earlier (Tuesday). The fee for the early day is \$30.

CHAPTER FAIR: There will be a Chapter Fair on Wednesday, January 7, 2026, at the Fullenwider Building 9 from 1:30 p.m.-3:00 p.m. Meet with chapter representatives and join a chapter to add more fun & fellowship to your RV life.

BINGO: Wednesday, January 7, 2026, 7:00 p.m.-9:00 p.m. in the Fullenwider Building 9. Doors open at 6:00 p.m.. Includes a \$500 Blackout game prize (sponsored by River Run RV Resort).

PARADE: Thursday, January 8, 2026, 4:00 p.m. There will be a colorful parade designed around the "Roaring 20s" rally theme with floats, Western Area and National Officers, and chapter representatives.

OPENING CEREMONY: Thursday, January 8, 2026, 7:00 p.m. Hear Western Area and National Officer updates, National & WRVA Officers are introduced, chapters & volunteers are acknowledged. Entertainment follows.

LADIES LUNCHEON: Friday, January 9, 2026, at 1:00 p.m.-3:00 p.m. (doors open at 12:45 p.m.). Ticket price is \$20.00. Tickets can be purchased at the door beginning at 12:15 p.m. Pick up tickets purchased when you registered on Wednesday or Thursday from 9:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m. at Building 9 (Auditorium) Lobby.

TWO ICE CREAM SOCIALS: Thursday, January 8, 2026, 12:00 p.m.- 1:00 p.m. and Saturday, January 10, 2026, 1:00 p.m.-2:00, both at the Town Center (under the flag pole at the Taj Mahal Grassy Area).

PET EXTRAVAGANZA SHOW: There will be a "Roaring 20s" Pet Extravaganza Show on Saturday, January 10, at 2:00 p.m. in the Amphitheater. Five categories will be judged with ribbons and prizes awarded.

ARRIVAL PROCEDURES

DIRECTIONS: From Interstate 10 East or West, take Monroe Street (exit 142) and exit South. Go three (3) miles on Monroe to Avenue 48. Turn left and go ½-mile on Avenue 48 to Oasis Street. Turn left on Oasis Street and go to Dr. Carreon Boulevard and turn left at the Stop light. Go ¼ mile on Dr. Carreon Boulevard and turn Right at the second gate into the Arrival Area. Note: Do not use GPS directions as they will have you coming in the wrong way and unable to make turns into the fairgrounds.

ARRIVAL AREA/PARKING: Arrival Area parking hours begin Sunday, January 4, 2026, at noon and end at 4:30 p.m. Parking hours will continue daily from 8:00 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. The WRVA Parking Crew will be on duty to assist you upon your arrival. If you arrive before January 7, 2026, you will be charged \$30 per night camping fee, payable by check or cash. There will be no early arrivals before January 4, 2026.

If you registered for Disabled Parking, please display your valid DMV issued sticker/tag in your front windshield.

If you have a tow vehicle, the parking crew requests that you unhook it in the Arrival Area so this does not hold up the parking operation once you have been taken to your assigned parking site.

If you wish to park close to friends, you and your friends must arrive together with appropriate admittance credentials. All RVs in the caravan must have the same parking credentials. Please identify your party by placing, in each drivers windshield, a piece of white 8 1/2" x 11" paper that has the last name of one of the members of your group followed by the position each RV occupies in your party (Smith 1 of 3; Smith 2 of 3; Smith 3 of 3, etc.) written in a heavy, black marking pen. These should be in the lower left-hand corner of the driver's side of your front windshield.

GENERAL INFORMATION

NOTE: Enclosed in your credentials packet are all of your registration materials with the exception of the rally program, hatpins, and badge holders, which you will receive at the rally with your Welcome Bag.

DUMP STATION: Please come to the grounds with **EMPTY HOLDING TANKS** and a **FULL FRESH-WATER TANK**. There is a dump station located south of the arena west of Gate 9.

CANCELLATIONS: Refunds will be made only upon written request, (wmhatreasurer6@gmail.com) and may require Executive Board approval. All badges and materials must be returned to WRVA before any refund is issued. Cancellations made by October 15, 2025, will receive a refund minus a \$50 processing fee. Cancellations made after October 15, 2025 but before November 30, 2025 will receive a refund minus a \$75 processing fee. No refunds will be made for electric after December 1, 2025. **Absolutely no refunds will be made after December 5, 2025.**
